New Conference Model

TWO deadlines: April and August

No overlapping between the two review phases

- Papers could be submitted at only one deadline
- Accepted papers of the 1st phase were definitely accepted
- ▶ Papers rejected from the 1st phase could be resubmitted to the 2nd phase In case of resubmission, reviews from the 1st phase were transmitted to the reviewers of the 2nd phase

Only 6 of the 15 rejected papers of Phase 1 were resubmitted to Phase 2!


All continents except Antarctica!

Maximum number of authors for a submission: 15


Average number of authors for a submission: 3.06

Reviews


- Double Blind
- ▶ ≥ 3 reviews per papers, except for invited papers (2 reviews)
- ▶ Timeline
 - * Review phase: 1 month
 - * Discussion: 1 week


Overall acceptance rate for regular papers (invited papers excluded): 31.4%









